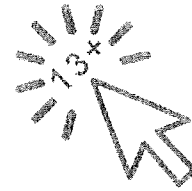

## SCHOOL INTERNET-BASED TOOLS PERMISSION (FOR STUDENTS 13 YEARS AND OLDER)



An important part of student learning will involve using Internet-based tools to create and share learning while developing digital literacy skills. Students will use these Internet-based to:

- Explain and document learning
- Communicate with other learners
- Store and manage assignments and other information

General safe practices will be reinforced when interacting with online service, such as taking care to avoid posting personal information or personal location that could be used to identify individual students. Your written consent for your child's use of this Internet-based tool is required by British Columbia's Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FIPPA).

It is important to be aware that the **Internet-based tools** noted below are online services hosted outside of British Columbia and possibly Canada. While stored outside the country, information in your child's accounts may be subject to the laws of foreign jurisdictions, including, in the United States, the USA Patriot Act
